



# VIGNA RÒDA

The Euganean Hills are a group of hills of volcanic origin that rise above the Padovan-Venetian plain a few miles south of Padua. This geologically rich landscape is where the Strazzacappa family has rooted their wine tradition by putting years of work and passion for wine into Vigna Roda. The area, located within the Regional Park, is particularly suitable to viticulture. The dynamic winery of the Strazzacappa family, now led by Gianni and his wife Elena, are already established as producers of high quality wines.



## MOSCATO SPUMANTE DOLCE

Vines of 100% Moscato Giallo (Yellow Muscat)  
Indigenous Italian grape

Vines were planted in 2001

Soil type is ancient alluvial volcanic material

The color is clear straw yellow with a fine and lasting perlage

The aroma is fresh with a characteristic hints of elderflower and orange blossom

It is sweet with a fair acidity that enhances its crispness

This wine can be served with all dry and fresh pastries, it is also highly suggested as aperitif
